

The *Fondation du Collège de l'Immobilier* Launches its Scholarship Program!

The Scholarship Program of the *Fondation du Collège de l'immobilier du Québec* helps reduce tuition fees for eligible, full-time Collège students enrolled in one of these programs: Residential Real Estate Broker, Mortgage Broker or Commercial Real Estate Broker.

The scholarships have maximum value of \$750 and will be awarded for as long as the *Fondation du Collège* continues the scholarship program and available funding is exhausted. The *Fondation* is not committed to providing a grant for every submitted scholarship application even if it meets eligibility requirements. The *Fondation* may terminate the program at any time.

Eligibility Requirements

- Be a Canadian citizen or have permanent resident status
 - Be a resident of Québec
 - Be a full-time student in a credited program at the Collège de l'immobilier du Québec
 - Have a gross annual income for the previous year of:
 - 60 000 \$ or less (single individual) *
 - 80 000 \$ or less (family income – individual with spousal support) *
 - Provide the last Notice of Assessment from Revenu Québec
 - Provide a summary of 400 to 750 words explaining the reasons you would like a career in real estate
- * add \$1,800 per dependant child

Steps

Students that meet the eligibility requirements and have received enrolment confirmation from the Collège must fill out an application form and provide required supporting documents (Notice of Assessment from Revenu Québec after last income tax return). They must also provide a typed summary of 400 to 750 words explaining the reasons why they would like a career in real estate.

Fax : 514 762-4975. These documents must be received by the deadline set by the Collège, which is one week after the start of the student's classes or programs.

Selection Criteria

- Must meet all eligibility requirements
- The application must be complete
- Quality of provided summary

Scholarship Process

Students who are granted a scholarship will be informed by letter in the ten days following the application deadline. A copy of the letter will be included in their file. Students who are granted a scholarship will receive a check from the *Fondation*.
