- **By correspondence**

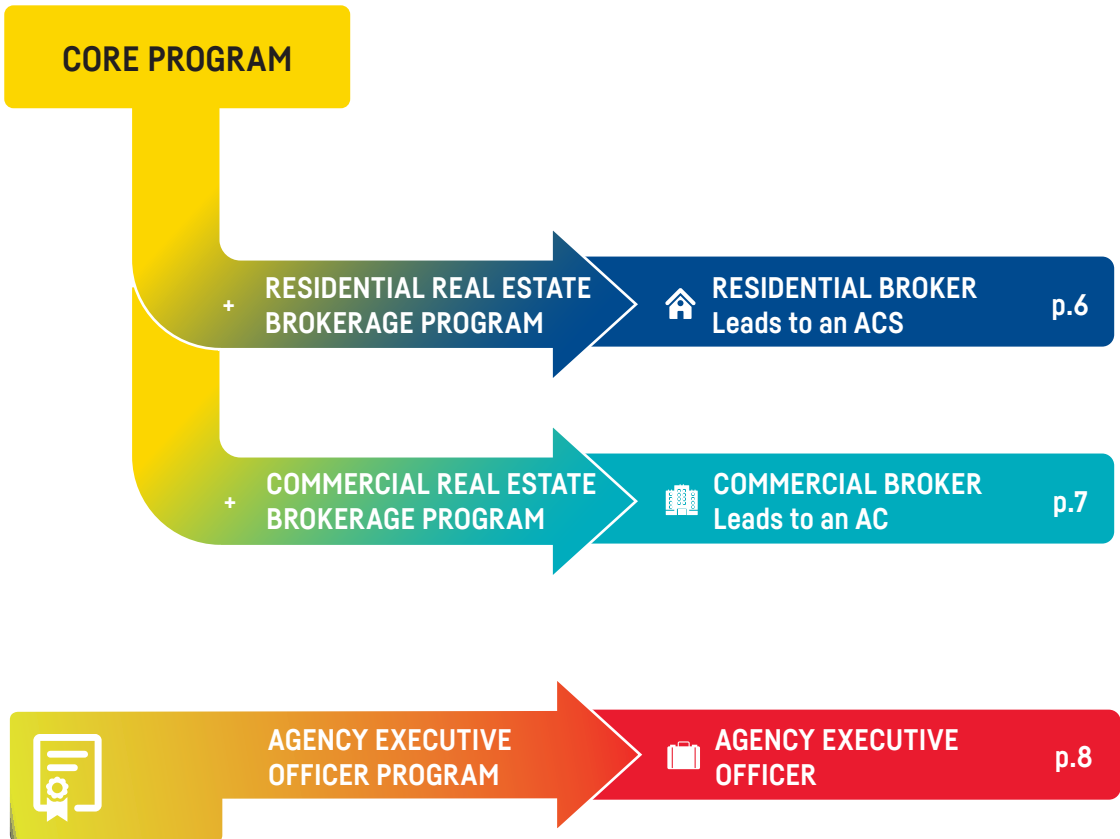

Admission requirements

Is eligible for the Agency Executive Office program (DAA.01), the real estate broker who holds a valid permit from the OACIQ. The student will need to provide a copy of his permit when registering.

ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to being entitled to study and work in Québec, applicants must first meet one of the following admission requirements to be eligible to the Collège's ACS programs:

Hold a Québec High School Diploma or a vocational studies diploma (VSD) or an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary V Studies (AESS)

OR

Have training deemed sufficient by the Collège.

For studies done abroad

You must provide a comparative evaluation of your degree by the *Ministère de l'immigration, Diversité et Inclusion* and a translation of said document, if needed, into French or English.

For students who do not meet these specific requirements

An official high school transcript as well as a résumé and a letter of motivation must be provided. The Collège de l'immobilier will conduct a case review for admission.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

The following documents must be provided by email or in person:

Proof of education according to the conditions listed previously. We will accept your high school diploma (equivalent or higher degree) or your official transcripts.

Proof of identity. Only one of the following documents is required:

- a birth certificate (long form) issued by a Canadian province;
- both sides of a citizenship card or a citizenship certificate (for naturalized Canadian citizens);
- the Record of Landing [IMM 1000] or the Confirmation of Permanent Residence [IMM 5292 or IMM 5688];
- both sides of a permanent resident card;
- a work visa (for temporary residents waiting for the immigration process);
- a study permit.

Note that a passport, a driver's licence or a health insurance card are not accepted. As well, if you don't have a permanent code issued by the MEES, in addition to the documents specified above, you must provide a legible document, such as your birth certificate, indicating your place of birth (city and country) and the last and first names of both your parents.

VALIDATION OF OACIQ COMPETENCIES ACTIVITIES [available for residential and commercial real estate programs]

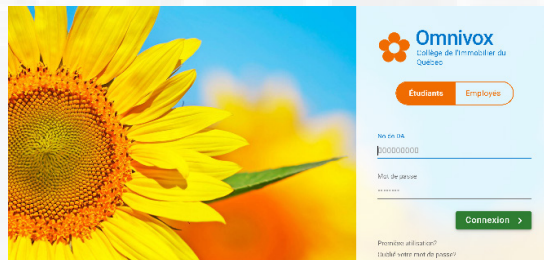
