- **By correspondence**

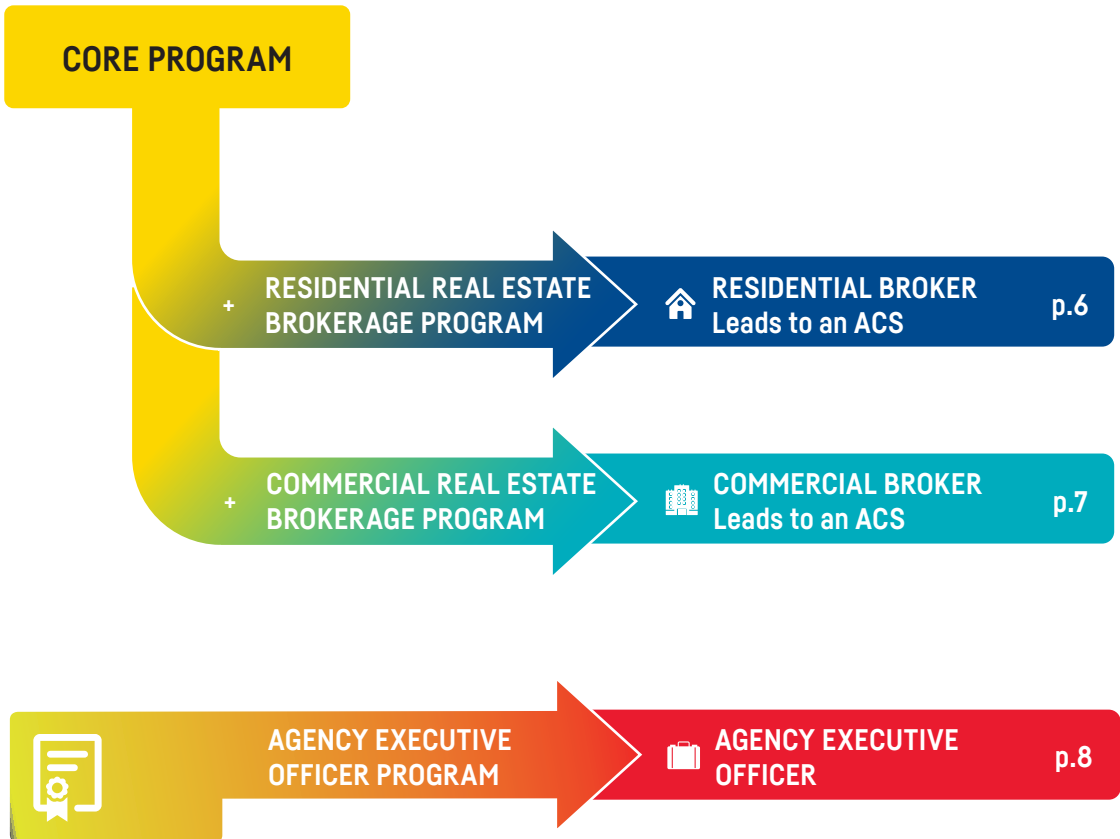

Admission requirements

Is eligible for the Agency Executive Office program [DAA.01], the real estate broker who holds a valid permit from the OACIQ. The student will need to provide a copy of his permit when registering.

CEUs: The new agency executive can be awarded 10 CEUs, for having passed the agency executive certification exam. CEUs are awarded for the cycle during which the exam was passed. ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Is eligible for an ACS program at the Collège de l'immobilier du Québec, anyone who meets one of the following conditions:

- Hold a Québec High School Diploma or a vocational studies diploma (VSD) or an Attestation of Equivalence of Secondary V Studies (AESS)

OR

- Have training deemed sufficient by the Collège.

For studies done abroad

You must provide a comparative evaluation of your degree by the *Ministère de l'immigration, Diversité et Inclusion* and a translation of said document, if needed, into French or English.

For students who do not meet these specific requirements

An official high school transcript as well as a résumé and a letter of motivation must be provided. The Collège de l'immobilier will conduct a case review for admission.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

You must provide proof of education and proof of identity:

Proof of education:

- Secondary School Diploma (SSD) or higher or official transcript.
- or AESS (Secondary level equivalence certificate) from Québec.
- or GED (general education development) from Ontario or any other province of Canada

Proof of identity:

- Birth certificate (large format) issued by a Canadian province (exception for Ontario, where the small format certificate is accepted).
- or Citizenship card (front/back).
- or Citizenship certificate (2 pages format).
- or Form relating to the right of establishment [IMM 1000] or confirmation of permanent residence [IMM 5292 or IMM 5688].
- or Permanent resident card or study permit (must be valid on the course start date).
- or Work permit (exceptionally from June 27, 2023, to June 27, 2026).

Please note that passports, driving licenses or health insurance cards are not accepted as proof of identity.

VALIDATION OF OACIQ COMPETENCIES ACTIVITIES [available for residential and commercial real estate programs]

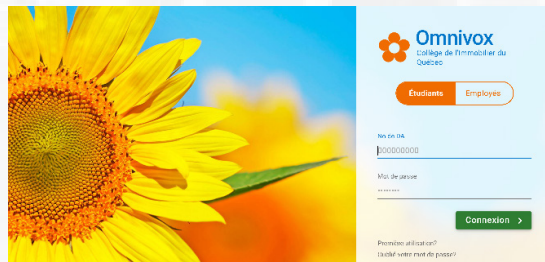
